Haryana Police Constable Selection Process:


The selection process for the <u>Haryana Police Constable exam</u>:

- 1. CET Score
- 2. Knowledge Test
- 3. Physical Screening Test
- 4. Physical Measurement Test
- 5. Additional Weightage
- 6. Miscellaneous Weightage



A. Knowledge Test

- (a) The medium of examination shall be bilingual i.e. both in Hindi as well as in English.
- (b) An Offline (OMR base) written examination for Knowledge Test will be held for recruitment for the post of Constable
- (c) The exam will consist of objective-type questions only.
- (d) There will be no negative marking for wrong answers.
- (e) The Test will be of 94.5 marks.
- (f) The test will have 100 questions, each question carrying 0.945 marks.
- (g) Minimum 50% marks for general category and minimum 40% marks for reserved category are required to be obtained in the knowledge test.



B. Physical Screening Test

- (a) The screening test does not carry any marks, it will be qualifying in nature.
- (b) The candidates who qualify the standards prescribed for this test will undergo a Physical Measurement Test further.

C. Physical Measurement Test

The Physical Measurement Test conducted by the board. The board will take measurement of the chest, height, etc of the candidates and if any candidates fail to meet the standard then he or she can't move further in the selection process. The Physical Standards are different for men and women candidates, check the Physical Eligibility Criteria mentioned above to know the detailed information about it.

D. Additional Weightage

The Additional Weightage of (maximum 03 + 2.5 = 5.5 marks) will be provided as given below: -

- (a) NCC certificate: Candidates having NCC certificate of A, B or C level shall get 01, 02 and 03 marks respectively (for Constables).
- (b) Socio Economic Criteria: Maximum two and half (2.5) percent socio-economic criteria weightage shall be admissible to eligible candidates as per Common Eligibility Test Policy.

The Haryana Police Constable syllabus includes General Studies, General Science, Current Affairs, General Reasoning, Mental Aptitude, Husbandry and basic computer knowledge.
